## **National CLAS Standards Dissemination**

The Wyoming Department of Health, Office of Multicultural Health created a National Standards on Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS)<sup>1</sup> webpage. The webpage provides links to external CLAS resources, including documents and introductory videos from the federal Office of Minority Health; an online training and toolkit created by the New Mexico Department of Health; and the website of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign Early Childhood Research Institute on Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services. The Office of Multicultural Health also disseminates information about the National CLAS Standards in its monthly newsletter.<sup>2</sup>
